We are glad to see hat heavy vehicle safety is a priority area.

Under 'actions' for heavy vehicle safety, a point should be added to increase community education campaigns to help improve understanding of road behaviour around heavy vehicles.

This can be supported by the 2020 NTARC Major Accident Investigation Report that outlines where a truck and car were involved in a fatal crash, the car was at fault 80% of the time. (This figure has never been outside of the band 80-100% in a decade). The report shows a continual increase in serious crashes involving heavy vehicles caused by light vehicles.

It's also important to draw on private sector experience in all discussions related to heavy vehicles and road safety .
