



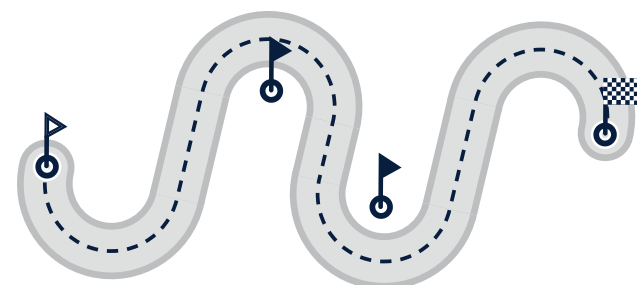

PRE-PROVISIONAL COURSE

All states and territories



HAZARD PERCEPTION TEST + 50HR LOGBOOK

WA* | Qld and SA** (test only)

* 50 hours including 5 hours of night driving.
Logbook not required if over 25 years or already
hold a car licence.

** Riders are only required to do the normal car
HPT if they haven't already done so as part of their
car learner's permit.

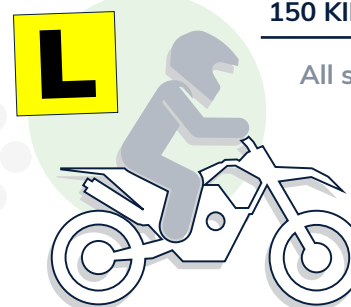

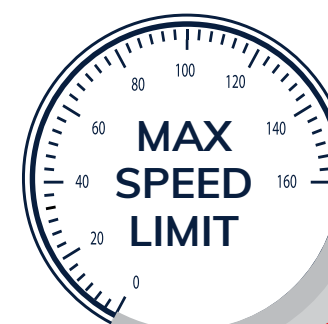
